### 2025 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR COASTAL RACES

These Sailing Instructions are to be applied in conjunction with

### 2025 General Sailing Instructions A - All Fleets

#### 1. DESIGNATING THE COURSE

The course will be designated by the Race Committee before the first start sequence of the day and announced by VHF radio on Channel 74. Failure to receive radio call shall not be grounds for redress. Marks to be used may include for example, The Muglins, Yellow Outfall off West Pier, inflatable marks and the starting line mark.

#### 13. FINISHING LINE

13.1 The finishing line shall be between the main mast of the Committee Boat and the finishing mark. The location and description of this line will be announced on VHF Channel 74. Failure to receive radio call shall not be grounds for redress. If the course is shortened the finishing line will be between Committee Boat and the nearby mark.

#### 14. TIME LIMIT

The time limit shall be 17.30 hrs. Time limit may be extended due to postponements and the new time limit may be announced by VHF radio.
